NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and by the rules and prescriptions of Irish Sailing.
- 1.2 The rules of the Flying Fifteen Class will apply, in so far that they do not conflict with the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Fifteen Class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form on www.nyc.ie

4 FEES

The entry fee is € 90.00

5.2 If there have been races postponed, additional races may be run as required.

6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate
- 6.2 Each boat shall comply with local class safety equipment list.

6.3 The The Race Committee, or an official appointed by it, may inspect competing boats at any time during the series.

7 **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available for download on www.nyc.ie prior to the first race.

8 **VENUE**

NYC and the waters of Dublin Bay

9 **THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward Leeward and/or Windward Leeward Triangle.

10 **PENALTY SYSTEM**

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 **SCORING**

11.1 The scoring system is as follows: Appendix A Low Points System Long Series.

11.2 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.3 (a) When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 4 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 **RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13 **PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Additional prizes may be given for Silver and Bronze Fleet classifications, at the discretion of the Dun Laoghaire F15 fleet.

14 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
