Notice Of Race

The organising authority is the National Yacht Club and the Irish 2.4 Metre Association

Covid 19

This series will be Covid compliant and the organising committee requests that all participants take personal responsibility for themselves. Every Competitor should have their own appropriate hygiene equipment .

1.0 Rules

1.1 The event is governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

The prescriptions of Irish Sailing will apply

1.3 Part 1 of the equipment rules of sailing will apply

1.4 Any Change to this notice of race may be posted on www.nyc.ie

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 The regatta is open to members of the Irish 2.4MR association.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at www.nyc.ie no later than Wednesday 8th September.

2.3 Late entries shall be at the discretion of the Committee.

3.0 Entrance Fee

3.1 The entry fee for each boat is 25 Euros the entry is completed online

Schedule 4.0

4.1 Registration is online only

4.2 The schedule time of the warning signal for first race on Saturday 11th July is 1155 and each race will start ASAP after race 1 . There are three races scheduled on Saturday 11th September .

4.3 On Sunday 12th September the warning signal for the first race will be at 10.55 am and the subsequent races will be as soon as possible thereafter . There are three races scheduled on Sunday

4.4 In addition, in the case of adverse weather conditions being experienced or forecast additional races may be held on each of the given days. These will be signified by Flag R over the Class flag at the end of the preceding race .

4.5 The class flag shall be flag Q

4.6 No warning signal will be made after 1500hrs on Sunday 12th September .

5.0 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available from the on-line race office at the National Yacht Club which can be found at www.nyc.ie

6.0 Notices to competitors will be posted on www.nyc.ie

7.0 Changes to Sailing Instructions

7.1 Changes will be posted two hours before the first warning signal of the race that such changes take effect

7.2 Changes to the schedule of the first warning signal of a race day will be posted before 20.00 on the day before it is due to take effect

8.0 Substitution of sails or replacement of hulls

8.1 Boats shall show a distinguishing number on each side of the mainsail, which shall be the same as declared on her entry. A boat intending to change a sail number shall give written notice to the race committee before the warning signal of the race concerned. This Request can be sent by email to Sailing@nyc.ie No boat may use the same sail number as another boat in the event

No substitution of hulls will be allowed without prior written approval of the Race Committee.

10.0 Race Area and Courses

10.1 The race area will be Dublin Bay or Dunlaoghaire Harbour depending on conditions

10.2 The courses to be sailed will be Windward / Leeward .However the race committee reserves the right to change the course as it sees fit.

11.0 Scoring

11.1 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship

11.2 The low points scoring system of RRS appendix A will apply

11.3 Once 4 or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race excluding her one worst score.

12.0 Prizes

12.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 boats .

13.0 Disclaimer of Liability

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, The organising authority will not accept any liability for material, damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

14.0 Insurance

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of not less than 1.5 million EURO.

15.0 Photography Consent

By entering the series competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the Club facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, re-use, publication and re-publication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitors name or not, without compensation and without the competitors approval of such images or any use thereof.

16.0 Temporary Membership

16.1 Competitors and race committee are granted temporary membership of the National Yacht Club for the duration of the event.
